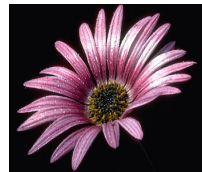

Heartland Presbytery Meeting Highlights

June 15, 2010

The 200th Stated Meeting Heartland Presbytery was hosted by the St. Paul congregation in the Linwood United Church in Kansas City, MO. The Rev. Andy Cullen, Pastor of John Knox Kirk preached the sermon "Remember When..." based on Jeremiah 31:31-34 and Luke 23:39-43. The worship service offering benefitted the Heartland Presbytery Youth Triennium Fund and totaled \$1,100.79.

The presbytery examined and enrolled Jennifer Barchi as a candidate for the ministry of the Word and sacrament. She is a member of Village Church and just finished her second year at Princeton Theological Seminary.

The presbytery also examined and welcomed three new ministers. Rev. Mary Jean Bird, pastor of the United Church in Lawson, MO; Rev. Tim Fulop, Dean of William Jewell College; and Rev. Paul Rock, Second Presbyterian Church, Kansas City, MO.

The presbytery approved new position descriptions for the Executive Presbyter, the Associate Executive Presbyter and the Stated Clerk. Also approved was a severance package for former Acting Executive Presbyter Rev. David Cliburn.

Mission and Social Justice Ministries Division invited the churches to fund a month's salary for a nurse at the Thwake Village medical clinic for only \$250. One month was already sponsored.
